[3] Sever Residence

11108 East Harris Hawk Trail in Scottsdale - 85262



Aligned on a 23'-0" grid and being lot 23, this residence is quite, site specific. The structure was designed around every boulder outcropping. As you approach the home you will see the grid as the center of each stone column. Most of the livable space is above the boulders capturing views of the desert beyond and the city lights.

The most unique feature of the residence has to be the swimming pool. Supported by 3 columns the pool is entirely above ground and displays 3 porthole windows.



Constructed of masonry, concrete and steel, the home is built for permanence.

Guests arriving will first see the pool elevated above them and then walk under the structure through the shade and boulder garden, around native saguaros and ascend a short flight of stairs to the second level arriving at the front door at the rear of the home.
