The Shebraber School Project

The EthiopiaStudio2.0 sends 12 Arizona State University graduate students and 1 professional architect into a remote village community 120 miles southwest of Addis Ababa, the capital of Ethiopia, Africa.

The students will develop a master plan, landscape and architectural design and construction documents for the immediate construction of these desperately needed facilities to support the growth of education and potential in Mekana Kebele.

The project, called Shebraber School, will be built with local materials in a manner that honors the indigenous culture of the Garage region. Construction will be performed by Ethiopian builders and artisans; the facilities will be staffed by Ethiopians and will provide employment for many people in the community, creating hope and opportunity through meeting the desperate needs of the children and community.
